

One of La Mirada's Original Businesses Moving its Pharmacy

The owner of Valley View Rexall Drugs is moving the pharmacy portion of the business out of the building at Roseview Center North across the street to Roseview Center South, occupying two units.

The current store will remain and continue operation as a compounding drug manufacturer, mail center, and sellers of in-home supplies and mobility equipment, among other things.

The drug store operates as the retailer of its parent company, Valley View Drug Co, Inc.

Roseview North and South were the first retail centers built in La Mirada in the mid 1950's. The very first La Mirada city hall was housed at the south center.
